

Our Parish

We begun our journey as a parish on the weekend of July 12/13, 2008 with four Masses celebrated at St. Joan of Arc Catholic Secondary School. Group meetings were held at the basement of our Rectory. A few months later, we were granted permission to use St. Peter's Church on the Ninth Line by the Diocese of Hamilton. The first 7:30 AM Sunday Mass was held on October 19, 2008. On November 1, 2008 the Legion of Mary was organized and begun to meet at the church basement. All other groups started to meet there too. For nine years, despite the limitations of the church, hundreds of people came to worship and celebrate the sacraments. We will miss this little church, but we will always be grateful as a parish. It was in this little church that we were weaned. As a church of immigrants, we are most happy to connect our story with the Irish Catholics who came to farm this swamp in the 1800's. Their courage and devotion will continue to inspire us in the years to come.

I would like to especially thank everyone for all the assistance you have given for the upkeep of St. Peter's Church through the years. If I may, I would like to particularly mention JC Cadieux, who helped me manage the place, to Bella Laurente for her service as sacristan, and to Fausto Trinca for clearing the snow every winter.


