WISH LIST FOR THE NEW CHURCH





About two years ago, we received a donation of an old tabernacle from Mr. & Mrs. Wilfred Tyrell, St. Ignatius of Loyola Parish. According to Mr. Tyrell, the Tabernacle was found underneath a pile of old carpets in a warehouse he was inspecting in the US. Nobody knew where the Tabernacle came from or how long it had been there. Receiving permission from the warehouse owners, he brought the Tabernacle home and stored it in his garage for another eight years. The gift of the Tabernacle was like a sign from heaven. Shortly after we received it, permission to construct was also issued. I am happy to report to everyone that the Tabernacle is now refurbished and installed in the new church.

These are some more items that we will need in the new church:

- Behind the sanctuary is a small chapel where those who wish to pray closer to the Tabernacle will be able to do so. We would like to see a railing (similar to a communion rail) installed to separate the chapel from the passageway and the door to the Sacristy. The railing which will follow the design of our sanctuary space costs \$7350.
- 2) In our small chapel, we intend to have 20 stools with kneelers. Each stool costs \$275.
- 3) Also in the sanctuary are specially designed wood planters that will complement the design of the arches. There are six of these planters. Each of these planters costs \$1100.
- 4) We will also need two credence table. Each of these credence table cost \$1300
- 5) We will require 750 copies of the Catholic Book of Worship III to enable the community to actively participate in the Mass. Each copy of the Catholic Book of Worship costs \$21.95
- 6) We will need about 250 banquet chairs for the parish hall. Each chair costs \$50. Another 300 regular chairs for meetings, Each costs \$30.
