#### How well do you know the different parts of our church?

In a series of weeks, we will explain to you about the different parts of the church. On the façade of the church, as you stand in the corner of Thomas Street and Oscar Peterson Blvd., we find a landscaped plaza. The landscaped plaza is our ceremonial plaza. Here we will gather at certain times of the year, such as at the Easter Vigil for the blessing of fire. It is also here that wedding or funeral procession begins. Four removal bolards, two on each side on the rotunda, are put in place to separate the people from moving vehicles. There are three outer arches flanked by two rectangular entrances. Symbolically to represent the Trinity and the Dual nature of Christ. Practically, to serve as shade from the natural elements. Park benches are also provided. Please note that our grounds are smoke free zones. Let us make the surrounding grounds of our church always clean and beautiful at all times.

The Narthex in Greek means "giant funnel" and our architectural design of the narthex looks indeed like a funnel. It is the place where we greet one another before and after Mass. It is the area between the outside doors of the church and the inner doors leading into the worship space. This is where we are welcomed each Sunday, where baptisms begin. It is a place for religious literature and for parish notices or displays.

In the early history of the Church, the narthex was a waiting area for the unbaptized and penitents not allowed inside the worship space and not allowed to participate in all or part of the Mass. Through the centuries the restrictions on Mass attendance have been relaxed, but the term "narthex" remains.

In the narthex, we mentally discard our worldly ways, knowing that we are about to enter a holy ground and that our attitude, body language, and even our attire need to reflect the sacredness therein.

#### Pastor's Desk

Time for a checkup. Our lives have been extended, and for many, the quality of life has been improved because of rapid advances over the past few years for both medicine and communications. By better using the means of communication, especially television and the internet, the medical profession has been able to effectively alert the public to the danger signs of certain disorders. They have also devised means of self-examination and through early detection and treatment, lives have been saved and renewed hope for those whose health have already been adversely affected.

The Church has also a special time set aside to warn us of the danger signs of the one illness that touches all of our lives. That illness is sin, that which separates us from God and from one another. That special time is Lent.

Lent is a time for self-examination; a time to seek healing and a fuller more satisfying life. I am quite positive that if you are made aware of the danger signs of sin just like the danger signs of cancer, you will most likely examine yourself and seek help before it is too late. While the list below is not exhaustive, it will provide you with a good starting point for self-examination. Do you have any of these symptoms?

- Persistent anger
- Jealousy
- Constant dissatisfaction
- A constant desire to accumulate more of the "good things of life"
- Self-centeredness
- Constant criticism of others and a desire to change them
- Being out of communication with God failure to attend church and pray regularly
- Lack of charity
- Loss of your sense of humor
- Lack of hope

If you have one or more of these symptoms, don't delay, take immediate steps. Start by contacting Jesus. He still makes house calls.
