Pastor's Desk

There is smoke that is holy! The smell of incense is holy. It acts like a pillar of cloud that led Israel in the desert, leading us to smell the presence of the extraordinary in the ordinary.

My prayers rise before you like incense, O God. Is it any wonder that when they built their Temple to the invisible, inscrutable God, our older brothers and sisters in the Faith burned incense daily to accompany their prayers of petition and praise? What better way to attract the attention and arose the compassion of the God who was as elusive to the senses as a whiff of perfume yet as powerful to save as a pillar of fire and cloud?

We, too, honour God by incensing in this assembly, the Gospel Book, or the Altar Table. We fill this place with the fog of prayer in the morning as we sing Zechariah's blessing and again at dusk when we chant Mary's Magnificat. We raise the bread and wine on waves of incense. We swirl in sweet smoke the bride and groom. We send up the souls of the dead on clouds of perfume. Always before the cross go the ephemeral curls of frankincense and myrrh, cedar, sage and pine. This holy smoke carries our cries upward, raises up our praise, purifies the air of sin and sorrow. It dances delightfully above our heads and waltzes into our nostrils, filling our lungs with thanksgiving. It puts petitions on our lips; we pray for the world like Christ. We rise like incense!
