A young girl in our parish, accompanied by her parents, came give her donation towards the ongoing children's program. She just celebrated her birthday and decided to give her monetary gifts to the church. Thank you for this generosity and thank you to the parents. "A little bit more of our beloved patron saint, Josephine Bakhita. Bakhita had difficulty in reading as well as in writing, so her books were limited to a prayer book and the Canossian Rule. These she knew practically by heart. When people found her in the chapel absorbed in prayer, they often asked what she was meditating on, she would invariably reply: "I was meditating on the life of Christ, to know Him better and to love Him more." To make Him loved, she lost no opportunity to speak of His Gospel, to the children and to the orphans who lived in the Convent. The children appreciated and understood well the meaning of her stories and the signs of affection and devotion, which accompanied them. "I think I can say that Bakhita exercised the Christian virtues in a heroic manner, not so much because what she did was extraordinary, but because she did it constantly, naturally, and joyfully," says Armando Toniello, a teacher of Arts in the School run by the Canossian Sisters in Schio."
