Feast of St. Josephine Bakhita

One of the titles that is ascribed to St. Josephine Bakhita and one that you are all familiar with because it is on our parish prayer is "Universal Sister". It is a title that the great St. John Paul II ascribed to her on her beatification. In these words, we find the relevance of Bakhita today described in a nutshell. She has an extraordinary ability to address the people of our times. Her spirituality springs from simple things; her serenity when confronted with death and the pressing problems of life; her unconditional confidence in God and her constant urge to relate to Him; her outstanding goodness that expresses itself in her desire to forgive and that those who enslaved and tortured her may be saved. She is so far from those attitudes that prevail in our society today, and that alienate us from others, such as presumption, intolerance, revenge, the desire to assert oneself, pride, self-righteousness.

The Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Isaiah, Paul, and Peter had one thing in common. They were all humbled and felt unworthy in the face of God, and yet privileged to be cleansed and called to God's work. Each Sunday, we go through the same process ourselves at Mass. When the priest holds up the Eucharist and say: "Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world. Happy are those who are called to His Supper," your reply is "Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed." Just like Isaiah, Paul, and Peter, we recognize our unworthiness in the face of God, but show faith that God ca heal us and make us better. And like them, we too are called to go out into the world and be ambassadors of reconciliation, living out the Good News and making a difference in the world.
