Two powerful emotions appear in today's readings: fear and doubt. These readings depict challenging times both immediately following Jesus' death and resurrection and even in our own time. There was good reason to be fearful if you were a follower of the crucified Jesus. Good reason, too, if you lived in a place that is hostile to the proclamation of the Gospel. And so, the disciples are locked in a room out of fear and for us today too, we may be paralyzed by

fear – places of worship anywhere in the world may be targeted by terrorism and the like. And so, the disciples are locked in a room out of fear, and the first words spoken to John by the "one like the Son of Marn" are "Do not be afraid."

Where there is fear, doubt is just around the bend. But if we listen very carefully to the Gospel, we note that Thomas - despite his doubt - becomes a bleiever. His "show me" attitude probably produced much more than he barganed for. From the moment he uttered "My Lord and my God!" he opened himself to endless possibilities.

In this Easter season we are confronted with the heart of the gospel message: Jesus stands before us, pierced and marked by nails, his face "like the sun shining with full force." If, like Thomas, we dare to ask to encounter him face-to-face, we must be prepared to hear his words: "Do not be afraid."
