At each Mass, we hear the priest speak those words first uttered by Christ, words that continue to reverberate throughout all time. Listen carefully to those words that gift us beyond all measure, beyond all comprehension. Let your heart and soul join him as he prays, "This is my body; this is my blood."

We will approach the altar to receive the body and blood of Jesus Christ, so that we become one with him. Are we worthy? Of course not! If we waited to be worthy, we would never approach. No one will.

In Luke's gospel we hear, "...he healed those who needed to be cured." That is us, for each of us is in need of healing. We pray, in all truth, "Lord, I am not worthy." Yet we come with confidence because he invites us.

As with most things that we do on a regular basis, we face the danger of letting our reception of Eucharist become routine. That would be a tradgedy! We can never, never take it for granted, for in Eucharist we share the gift of surpassing all others. Jesus the Christ, who comes to dwell within us. Let us make him welcome.

Does God really care what we wear in church?

God does not explicitly endorse either formal or casual clothes in corporate worship. He doesn't even enter the debate. In fact, outside of ritual Levitical laws that no longer apply in the new covenant, God says virtually nothing regarding how we should dress when we come together to worship him.

It's not that clothing doesn't matter to God. Clothing matters a great deal to God — just not in the same ways or for the same reasons it typically matters to us. God refuses to decide the formal-casual debate, but he does explicitly tell us what he wants us to wear to church:

Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." (1 Peter 5:5)

What are we supposed to wear? Humility.

All clothing — formal, casual, work, sport, beachwear, sleepwear, underwear, headwear, every other kind of wear — can be a source of great pride. There isn't a clothing item or style that we can't turn into an

expression of self-centered, self-exalting self-worship.

But if we clothe ourselves with humility, if we "count others more significant than [ourselves]," and "look not only to [our] own interests, but also to the interests of others," then no matter how we dress, we will honor and reflect Christ (Philippians 2:3–4).


