

In the Gospel of Luke today we hear Jesus talking about humility. Our Gospel acclamation today says, "I am meek and gentle of heart." Indeed, this quality of humility is one for which Jesus is very much a role model. We often talk about how Jesus lowered himself to become like us - a God becoming a man! How much more humble could he be? So when Jesus talks about humility we know that he is "walking the talk"!

Jesus' parables are always about more than

they seem to be. The kingdom of heaven does not follow the rules and logic of any culture. God's ways cannot be understood in human terms. Social position means nothing to God. In fact, Jesus tells us that Jesus is compassionate and drawn to the lonely, the poor, the downhearted, the disabled. They are the ones who will be exalted in the kingdom of heaven. Having nothing but their ability to trust in God, they will be rewarded in heaven far above those who had position and honor and wealth in the earthly kingdom. The greater you are, the more you must humble yourself; so you will find favour in the sight of the Lord.
