Who are the Pharisees?

If all we know about Pharisees is what we read in the Bible, we don't really have a very accurate picture of who they really were. The Pharisees were Jews who formed an exclusive sect who wanted to do more than was required of the ordinary Jew of the day especially in the area of fasting, praying, and helping others by giving alms. Any group that wants to do more often becomes a target of criticism and the Pharisees as a group was no different. What is being criticized in the Gospels, however, is not that they try to do more, but rather the motives behind what they do. It is very easy for anyone to feel self-righteous when they are doing more than they should. We see this not only in the church. We also see this even in our workplaces. Jesus consistently preaches that if you become self-righteous, you are getting your reward for good behavior right now.

On the other hand, tax collectors have had a better rap in the Gospels. They were often looked down by the general population. For Jesus, the particular tax collector in today's gospel story had the proper attitude and understanding of his relationship to God. He had humility. It is the need for God that was counted as righteous by Jesus. The tax collector knew he could be a better person. He knew that he was in most need of God's mercy. Our prayer needs to have to same perspective.

Renting the Parish Hall

The Parish Finance Council discussed the possibility of renting the Parish Hall and it was agreed that we will not be renting the parish hall at the present time. Our parish has no proper custodian and we are not in a position to hire one. The only exception to this rule is for families of the parish whose loved one's funeral is held at our church.


