

Death: Both a Tragedy and a Blessing

Death was never part of God's primary purpose for His creation. He created us, not that we should die, but that we should live. We are an integral whole of body and soul. When the body and soul separates, the person dies. Death, therefore, is an affront to God's original design - a tragedy. For this reason, we feel desolate and angry. We grieve. Jesus Himself wept beside the grave of his friend, Lazarus. He was filled with dreadful anguish at the Garden of Gethsemane when he was faced with the possibility of his own death. St. Paul talks about it as an "enemy to be destroyed" (1 Cor. 15:26). Yet, even though death is tragic, it can also be a blessing, an expression of God's mercy and compassion.

In God's manifold wisdom, God is able to shape anew what was broken at the moment of death, like a master potter who reworked the broken vessel into another vessel as seemed good to him (Jeremiah 18). Death is our restoration!

Paraphrasing St. Paul in our second reading today: "May the Master take our beloved dead by the hand and lead them along the path of God's love. May the Master never let them down. stick with them and protect them from all evil.


