This Sunday brings us to the end of the Liturgical Year with the celebration of Christ as the King over all. "All time belongs to him



and all the ages," procalim, we as the candle prepared is at the Easter Vigil. This feast echoes that proclamation. The author of

the Letter to the Colossains shares a hymn that most likely the early Christian community sang, wherein the superiority of Jesus and his unique role in creation is firmly established.

When we look at Jesus, we see the God who cannot be see. We look at Him and see God's original purpose in eveverything created. For everything, absolutely everything, above and below, visible and invisible, rank after rank after rank of angels - everything got started in Him and finds its purpose in Him. He holds everything together including the church. Take Him out of the equation, everything falls apart.

The late and well-regarded Superior General of the Society of Jesus, Pedro Arrupe, was once asked the question: "What difference does Jesus make?" He wrote, "For me, Jesus Christ is everything. He was and is my ideal ... He and was and continues to be my way; he was and he still is my strength. I don't think it is necessary to explain very much what that means. Take Jesus Christ from my life and everything would collapse - like a human body from which someone removed the

skeleton, heart and head ... "
