Today's Gospel lays out for us the wonderfully dramatic scene of Christ's return as the early Christians imagined it. Using the ancient and related images of kingship, authority, and judgment, the gospel writer sets the stage for a royal return of spectacular proportions. Who would not recognize the One surrounded by angels and seated on a throne of glory?

But once again, God's word is full of surprises, as Jesus confounds our expectations about how he will be recognized and his criteria for recognizing his chosen ones. Jesus tells us that our familiarity with him will be best cultivated by our deep awareness of and service to the most vulnerable and needy among us. Obviously, to really sharpen our vision, it is not enough merely to notice those in need when they cross our paths, although that would be a good start.

Like parents or lovers whose eyes whose eyes and ears operate to a maximum capacity, we are called to be willing to seek out our neediest brothers and sisters. We do not have to look far or in obscure places. They might just be within our own households or even next door to our house. To see the needy is to see Christ. Whatever you do to the least of your brothers and sisters, you do it to Christ.




