St. John Paul II wrote in *Familiaris Consortio*, "St. Joseph was a just man, a tireless worker, the upright guardian of those entrusted to his care."

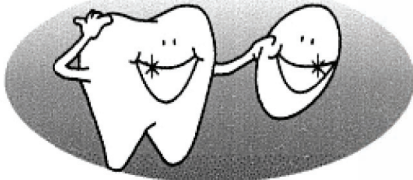
