The Story binds us together.

It seems wonderful that Jesus could say, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing." And it is. But what is just as wonderful is that every lector can say the same thing.

Just as Ezra read the story of the Jewish people to unite, inspire, and nourish them. and just as Jesus did the same, Luke tells us, the church tells the story all over again.

Of all the things we could do to unite us, to nourish us, to make us a community, our tradition, going all the way back to Ezra says that we should read the story. When we read the story, we learn who we are. We aren't Christians because of a moral code or a set of laws. We are Christians because we live the story. And when we want to deepen our Christian faith, we retell the story.

And then, like the people led by Nehemiah, we rejoice and have a feast.

SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD

"...At the conclusion of the Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy, I propose setting aside "a Sunday given over entirely to the word of God, so as to appreciate the inexhaustible riches contained in that constant dialogue between the Lord and his people"; Devoting a specific Sunday of the Liturgical Year to the Word of God can enable the Church to experience anew how the risen Lord opens up for us the treasury of his word and enables us to proclaim its unfathomable riches before the world...

'Consequently, I hereby declare that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be devoted to the celebration, study, and dissemination of the Word of God. This Sunday of the Word of God will thus be a fitting part of that time of the year when we are encouraged to strengthen the bonds with the Jewish people and to pray for Christian unity. This is more than a temporal coincidence: the celebration of the Sunday of the Word of God has ecumenical value, since the Scriptures point out, for those who listen, the path to authentic and firm unity.

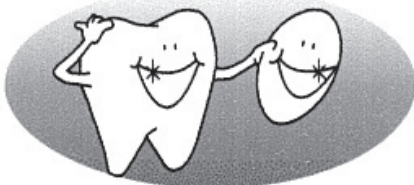
