GOD HELPS THOSE WHO STOP HURTING THEMSELVES

God is better able to help those who stop hurting themselves. Remember that remorse is the poison of life. Rabbi Harold Kushner recalls an experience which reminded him that remorse is often irrational and simply makes a bad situation worse. In his book, When Bad Things happen to Good People, he tells of a week in January when he officiated at two funerals for two elderly women in his community. Both lived long, productive lives and both succumbed to the normal wearing out of the body. Because their homes were near each other, Rabbi Kushner paid condolence calls to both families on the same afternoon. At the first home, the son of the deceased woman told the Rabbi, "if only I had sent my mother to Florida and gotten her out of this cold and snw, she would be alive today. It is my fault she died." At the second home, the son other deceased woman told the Rabbi: 'if only I hadn't insisted on my mother going to Florida, she would be alive today. That long, airplane ride, the abrupt change of climate, was more than she could take. It is my fault that she's dead."

Such remorse is not only irrational but it poisons life. Whenever experiencing remorse and regret, intionally make the decision to leave them behind. Commit yourself not to be burdened by selfdefeating and esteem-eroding thoughts of remorse. Instead, ask God to give you a new beginning.

God assures us through the Prophet Ezekiel: "I will cleanse you from all your impurities..I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you." (Ezekiel 36:26). Also again, "He who was seated on the throne said, "I am making everything new!" (Revelations 21:5). When you are deeply burdened by your past turn to God asking for a fresh start.


