# EASTER AND THE GLOBAL SITUATION

Easter is often dangerously misinterpreted as merely a spiritual event. Many prefer the faraway "transcendent" God; very few worship a God who gets close. Jesus was a close God: He lived, died, was buried, and lives again. Where? in poor children, and weary mothers, in jails, in long corridors of nursing homes, in war torn countries. In rich people who are poor inside. Jesus lives in the leftover people, the ones who are missing the living of their lives.

If Jesus were to rise today, he would rise in Ukraine. He would put a stop to the war, both metaphorically and actually. If Jesus were to rise today, he would forgive the debt of many people, so they can provide food for their families and sent their children to school, and not worry about their health care. If Jesus were to rise today, he would rise in the forgiveness of sins. Those who fail to take personal responsibility for their lives would find a ready forgiveness.

Easter is very much connected to the Year of Jubilee announced in the Old Testament - Forgiveness of everything so everyone can start afresh.

In Christianity, there is an unsevered relationship between liturgy and political community. The bread and wine are not just symbols. The heart and the soul are not disconnected from the body, nor is politics even slightly separated from religion.

Let us see in the rising of Jesus from the dead the all-powerful influence this brings into all areas of our lives!
