Life Shared with God

The readings today invite us to reflect upon the meaning of a life whared with God and with one another in God's church. Wile the core element of that communal life is God;s own love, as shared within the inner relationship of father, Son, and Holy Spirit, there are those times when tensions arise within our human community, when Jesus' farewell gift of peace seems to give way to disharmony and discord.

In the Acts of the Apostles, St. Luke describes a controversy that arose in the early church concerning the observance of the Mosaic Law. As the fledging commnity of Christians sought to find their own identity, it was inevitable and only natural the question shoud arise just how much of the Jewish Law should the gentile converts to Christianity be expected to observe?

The controversy even erupts into a public argument between Peter and Paul. The crisis forced the community into a deeper reflection on just what is believed.

The Gospel reflects upon the abiding presence of God within the community. We rejoice today to hear the reassuring words of Jesus: "Peace is my farewell to you, my peace is my gift to you." This is the epace that arises from the very presence of God in our midst. This is the peace that enabled the community to discover ways for reaching harmony within its diversity of backgrounds. This is the peace that is still very much alive and active within our own Christian community.

Difference of opinion among us are inevitable and natural. Yet the very presence fo God enables us to reconcile our differences, accept each other in love.

May God's wonderful gift of peace flouish and grow in midst each day!
