A Mystery of Faith

The doctrinal feast of the Holy Trinity is a good opportunity to remind ourselves of an important perspective. As Christians, everything we know about God we have learned through Jesus. The God we encounter through philosophy, for example, is significant in so far as it serves as a preamble to religious faith, but mixing reason and faith can sometimes reduced doctrine to logical problems that needed to be resolved and therefore, stale.

Jesus invites us to know God not as a mental conundrum but as an experience of intimate love overtaking us and ultimately sharing the divine identity with us.

The Trinity is a way of describing the early church's intimate encounter with God in Jesus Christ, a way of explaining how, after his earthly departure, Jesus stayed on in the community of believers through His Holy Spirit. The richness of this new understanding of God as a community of love is "unbearable" in the sense that early Jewish believers had to grow so much to grasp it. The unapproachable, ineffable God of the Old Testament is revealed as an intimate community of love in the New Testament. God is one but within that absolute unity the church proclaimed a mysterious communion of persons. To see Jesus is to see the Father. To receive the Holy Spirit was to possess the indwelling God, Father, Son, and Spirit.

Our path to understanding the mystery of the Trinity is our own experience of love in relationships. To love someone is to meet both the "who" of that person and the other "whos" that have formed the one we love. We say that marriage unites not just bride and groom but also both sets of parents, and together, as a family unity, they shall transform the world.

Even if we will never understand the Mystery of the Trinity, saying yes to this mystery is already an act of praise.
