# GOD'S FORBEARANCE

The first reading in today's Mass, from the Book of Wisom, is one of the strongest statements if God's mercy on all and God's desire that all people should be saved, 'since if you had hated something you would not have made it'. Again and again the Book of Wisdom makes much of God's forbearance, that sinners may have every chance to repent. This presents us with the clash: our love for God must be free, so that it is possible not to choose God. If our choice of God must be free, rejection of God must wonder if God have created anyone who not choose God? We do not know anyone actually rejected God. Hell is always a possibility. But we wonder if it is empty... We do not know and therefore, we have no right to judge the consciences even of those who we consider monsters, and it is hard to say that anyone has been without some spark of generosity or gentleness or goodness.

Jesus draws out our good intentions, before we are even really aware of them ourselves.
