#### CHRIST THE KING

King David provides an important backdrop for our understanding of Jesus as king. David was regarded as the apex of Jewish glory because of his vitality and power. But equally important was his passionate but flawed humanity. The same king who could dance before the ark was capable of adultery and murder. He was a man who won it all, lost it all, was fashioned as a human being before God by both victory and shame. His decline, both moral and regal, made him a sign of God's unconditional love for sinners. As failure humbled David and grief deepened his heart, so did it teach him the wisdom reflected in the psalms attributed to his authorship. The psalms capture the full range of human aspiration and suffering, the experience of descent from illuison and pride to dependency on God, who alone can give us life.

Jesus is the fulfillment of that human descent toward total surrender and God's promise to preserve the life of his beloved servant, even in the face of sin and death.

To give allegiance to Christ the King is to ask God to bring you to a baptismal maturity by opening your eyes and heart to the needs of others. You are a gift to this community, but a gift that will never unfold or achieve its full vitality unless it is released into the community. Only God could invite, then enable us, to take such a path to fulfill our royal priesthood in Christ.
