Our reading of the Passion draws us into the mystery of the God made visible in the crucified Christ. Paradoxically, these three hours - his suffering and death throes - are the most productive and purposeful of Jesus' life.

Everything he taught is now shown. His death is the culmination of a whole life of giving away for the sake of the community. Every parable is illuminated; the treasure is buried; the gain falls to the ground and dies; the bread is broken, the cup is poured out.

Every prophecy is fulfilled; the Paschal lamb is slain; the Son of Man is lifted up; the messiah is revealed as the Suffering Servant of Isaiah. The Law is fulfilled and justice is satisfied, even as mercy is poured out like blood to buy back the hopelessly guilty.

We are all pilgrims on the same road, our life stories now merging as we walk the same faith toward the same destination. How good it is to be in community. Who could do this alone?

Together we renew our surrender to live according to the Scriptures, to enter the great story of God's own purpose on earth.

We unite ourselves with Jesus in order to find meaning in our personal sufferings and losses, for dath is stalking all of us. Jesus says, "Follow me. Join your life to mine, offer your death together with mine. Make both life and death an act of love for the community, and I promise you, nothing will be wasted or lost. Empty yourself and you will find fulfillment."

The old gospel spiritual "Were you there?" asks us the most important question we will face these days. Are we there in Christ's Paschal mystery.

# WHAT IS THE PASCHAL TRIDUUM?

The Paschal Triduum is a single liturgical celebration that spans three days. it begins on the Holy Thursday and ends on Easter Sunday. "Isn't that four days?" you might ask yourself. The answer follows from Genesis "evening came and morning followed, the first day." Thus: Thursday evening to Friday evening (Day 1), Friday evening to Saturday evening (Day 2), Saturday evening to Sunday evening (Day 3).

The Paschal Triduum is a single liturgy encompases all three days. At the end of the Mass on Holy Thursday, you will notice there is no final blessing or dismissal. People are invited to pray quietly before the Blessed Sacrament and then leave when they are ready. It picks up again on Good Friday with the commemoration of the Lord's Passion. The service will not begin with the customary entrance song and sign of the cross, we simply pick up where we left off the evening before. We will leave again after the service without a formal dismissal. Another pause.

Although the Easter Vigil begins with the sign of the cross, it begins on a different location - outside, around a fire. It is only at the end of the Easter vigil Mass we hear the formal dismissal with double Alleluia!


