One way of undestanding the meaning of the resurrection for our lives is to use an analogy of a black coffee. The resurrection gives everybody black coffee - whether they want it or not. Just as God made the world without our leave and us without our permission, so God raised Jesus from the dead without our consent. We can appreciate what God has done or dismiss it, but our opinion does not alter the fact. Jesus is risen from the dead!

Now if you want cream or sugar, you have to add your own - as little or as much as you like. So is the resurrection. You can, for example, believe that Jesus was risen only and nothing more or you can go further by believing that it can also happen to you and because you believe that there is life after this life, you can then have a goal in life - a purpose and meaning - that all of your days and way are not merely futile striving, finally mocked by death.

You may also add that everybody will rise from the dead, that even history has a meaning - that at the end of time, there will be a curtain call and we will all gather to appreciate each other, to enjoy the marvelous unfolding of creation, and to be amazed at how God contrived to make such a complicated plot come out all right - and to applaud God.

The ressurection then becomes for us a pattern for everyday life - our ups and downs, our aches and pains are an extension of the death of Jesus. Every happiness is an expression of his resurrection. Every single thing that befalls us is an indispensable line in the script of our salvation.

This is our belief and our hope!
