The image of Jesus reaching out L to us in love is continued in the gospel reading today. In a beautiful pastoral setting Jesus pictures himself not only as the Shepherd whom the sheep will follow, but also as the gate to the sheepfold, providing a protected entrance and exit for the sheep to pass through. "Whoever enters through me will be saved." Yes, Jesus is the true shepherd who protects the sheep from harm, looks after their daily needs and assures them life. But in his own mystical way Jesus not only leads us along the right path; he indeed is the path; he is life itself. "I came so that they might have life and it more abundantly."

And yet again there is the matter of our response to the Shepherd's offer of guidance, to the Lord's offer of life. Pursuing the imagery of the sheep a little further, we realize that the sheep have their own important role to play in order for the shepherd to be successful. For the sheep are the ones who must be able to distinguish the shepherd's voice from all other voices; they are the ones who must take the initiative and be willing to follow that familiar voice calling out ot them. The options we face daily are many and varied. We have many choices extended to su, many farreaching decisions to make. Some are easy; many are complex and difficult. Yet the simple fact remains; the choice is ours. And God awaits our response.
