drunk", said some people who heard the sounds from the Upper Room. Some of you may have had the experience of having been drunk. May be as a young teenager when you had your first alcohol drink with your friends. What was the experience like for you? Aside from the swirling and the feeling of being lightheaded, may be you were excited, talkative, a bit more courageous, less inhibited and so on. Whatever your experience was, the people thought that the disciples were drunk that Sunday morning.

Yes, the disciples were drunk, but not with alcohol. They were drunk of the Holy Spirit. God filled and intoxicated the disciples with His love, mercy, grace, generosity, beauty, and power.

What does that mean? Well, have you ever received a gift that caught you so completely by surprise that you were left speechless? That kind of gift that is completely undeserved, unexpected, and unimaginable. You were probably overwhelmed with love, joy, and gratitude and at the same time grounded and clearheaded about the significance and meaning of that gift. That was Pentecost!

Pentecost is not just an event in the history of the Church. It is all around us. It is a grace that precedes, fills, and follows us. It transcends time, space, and the circumstances of our lives. The Holy Spirit is continually poured into our lives like new wine.

So, where is Pentecost happening for you? May you this day be filled to the brim with love, open your eyes to the mystery of God and the wonder and beauty of life. May the Holy Spirit come into your heart and through you touch other's lives in a wonderful way.


