As we contemplate on the Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity, we recognize the inadequacy of our everyday language. The more mysterious the emerging landscape, we call the Trinity, the further we must reach for appropriate language to describe it. Various terms have been put forward by believers down through the centuries and our generation is no exception. What we hope for and pray for today is to experience the Trinity.

We have a big God. St. Paul in his letter to the Ephesians writes: "I bow my knees before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name" (3:14). Every family in heaven and on earth! The Father is the one who gives life and shape to every kind of family, earthly and heavenly, which means that we discover what it means to by a parent by looking at him. We discover what it means to be family by looking at how he relates to the Son and the Spirit. Heavenly and earthly, all created and sustained by this Father.

All that makes God be God is inexhaustible. When this God gives, He gives out of a well that is full and bottomless. He, therefore, is able to give us more than we can ever imagine. For this reason, we can pray big prayers. A big God can handle big prayers. A little God, little prayers.

God had given to us His only Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, who suffered and died for us on the Cross. God also has given his Holy Spirit, not just any spirit, but His own Spirit, the same Spirit who hovered over the dark nothingness and brought into being the universe. It is the same Spririt who strengthens us, gives us the power to endure, to face all the challenges that come our way. All that we need!
