HERE IT IS

Well, it is Advent again. We are seeing some white dustings on the streets especially when we wake up in the morning. Advent is a wonderful season. It is that happy/sad time of year when we ready ourselves for the birthday of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ! This commemoration was underscored for me two months ago when I visited Bahrain. At the Grand Mosque, I met a well-educated guide who passionately explained to me, a non-Muslim, what it means to declare: "There is no God, but Allah, and Muhammad is His prophet." For followers of Islam, there is only the Creator, who made everything that exists possible. Mohammed was the prophet among many prophets, but He is not to be understood as intermediary between us and the Creator. In Islam, there is no such thing as the Mystery of the Incarnation and the guide at the Mosque was very empathic about it. Indeed, what makes us Christians, Christian, is our fundamental belief that God loved the world so much. He became human. The Creator became part of creation itself. As the Church Fathers loved to say: God became human, so we, humans will become divine! This is central to our belief system. Take this out and everything collapses. It is the primary reason why we celebrate Christmas. It is Jesus' Birthday Party. We celebrate it with more fervour and excitement.

Now, it is the same Jesus, who also promised to come gain. He will no longer be born and laid in a manger as what happened 2000 years ago in Bethlehem. He will come in great glory, with a blast of trumpets, and as Judge of the Liviing and the Dead. It would be nice if we know when, but we don't - the suspense can produce in us various emotions - it is probably why we do not like so much this waiting game - waiting is hard.

The Church, through the four weeks of Advent, help us go through this process. We invite everyone to enter into it as best as one could muster. If I may suggest, ask yourself: "What it is that I would like to do to prepare for Jesus' coming this season?
