IF THERE ARE LOTS OF SNOW

If there is a significant accumulation of snow in our slope rope this winter season, we would like you to enter and exit the church building via the entrance to the Parish Hall. We will close the inner courtyards on both sides for your safety. Please be guided accordingly.

One of the biggest expense of our parish during the winter months is the clearing of snow in our parking lot. We ask you to consider adding a few dollars to your regular offertory to offset this cost. To clear the snow and spread salt to melt the ice cost the parish close to \$6,000 per month (for roughly 6 months).

Take your time when entering and leaving our facility. If you see any ice build up especially where people usually walk, please do not hesitate to inform the parish desk immediately so we can address the problem ASAP.
