

WHAT ARE YOU LOOKING FOR?

We are now in the middle of January 2024, and the gospel is asking us: "what are you looking for in 2024? If you look at your life, your relationships, your work, and the world we live in, what are you looking for?

Is what you are looking for the same this year as it was last year? How about five years ago, ten years ago, twenty years ago? Has anything changed or is it still the same? Why is that?

Jesus is asking a question that has the power to change the course of our lives, of the world in which we revolve? What if we ask ask that question as a morning routine just as coffe may be a daily ritual for some of us?

Our answer might reveal who and where we are at in our life's journey. How would you answer that question today? Is your life headed in a good direction? If not, what would you think is needed to set things right.

"What are you looking for? What do you want?", Jesus inquired of the two disciples of John the Baptist who were following Jesus. John the Baptist gave his answer: "Jesus is the Lamb of God." But this was the answer of John. Jesus would ask again this question: "Who do you say that I am?" It is a question that each one has to answer an answer that stems from conviction and not just parroting what others have said about Him.

As we bring our needs and longings to the Lord, His invitation to us will always be: "Come and see." Jesus is always assuring us that if we go to him, if we spent time with him, if we allow him into our lives, he will be always be there for us and there will always something for us to experience.
