You know what it is like to have two minds and you feel bad about it. If you recognize contradictions in your life today, then today's Gospel reading is for you.

Jesus sets out contradictions between those who believe and those who do not, those who come to the light and those who love darkness, those who do what is true and those who do evil.

This is not just an either/or propostion. The truth is sometimes we believe and sometimes we don't. Sometimes we live the truth and sometimes we don't. Recognizing what is going in our lives - with all the contradicitons - is often painful. They hold things before us we don't want to see. They ask changes of us we don't want to make. They reveal our wounds, fears, and limitations. They remind us that sometimes we settle for easy and superficial solutions.

What if we want to lift up the contradictions in our lives just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness? What is if we lift everything to the Lord who was hanged for us on a tree?

Notice however, that whatever forms our contradictions might take they are ultimately about the contradiction between life and death. Each contains the other. The serpent that poisons also heals. The cross that kills is also the tree of life.
