The resurrection of Jesus compels us to step outside our usual understandings of human reality when He invites his disciples to "look at his hands and feet," "See, He says, that is I. Touch me and see; for a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have."

The resurrection of Jesus is revealed in through created order. It is not, however, bound by the created order. Rather, the resurrected body and life of Jesus wed heaven and earth together. If we limit eourselves only to the created order, that is when we bind ourselves through our fears, our sorrows and losses, our thoughts and distractions, our attachments and addictions, but when we connect with the Risen Jesus we are transformed.

Through the resurrection we experience unconditional love, unconditional forgiveness, unconditional life. Jesus desires to open our minds to understand that have been uncovered because of His life, death, and resurrection. This is not an academic or intellectual understanding. It is the awareness of the life that Jesus wants to give to us. We are therefore witnesses, not on what we know, but on who we are as sons and daughters of the resurrection.


