Wholeness requires us to acknowledge our own brokenness. "Where is our own house divided? In what way do we live fragmented lives? Anger and resentment, greed, insecurity, perfectionism, sorrow and loss. Fear. Envy. Guilt, Loneliness. Let us bring our conflicted lives to Jesus.
