Disillusionment is the tragedy of our times. We are all suffering from it in one form or another. There is disillusionment in our leaders, Church and politics, with our economy, with the endless wars and violence, prejudice and oppression and so on, including our own families, and even within ourselves. We are fearful what tomorow will be. Sleep deprives us. Everything seems to be on a downard spiral and out of control. Something has to be done and we are at loss who that person might be.

Disillusionment is a spiritual malaise and the Gospel comes to us today speaking about it. Peter was convinced Jesus was the answer, but he does not want what Jesus was saying about himself - as a suffering servant. So, Peter took him aside and rebukes him. Peter confesses and rebukes at the same time!

Listen to your own disillusionment and you will likely hear blessing and cursing coming from your mouth at the same time. There is conflict within ourselves and it comes out of our mouths. Our disullionment is not an excuse to curse or rebuke. It is not a basis for claiming we know more and better than another. It is not a reason to claim you are a genius and consider the other inferior.

"Get behind me Satan," Jesus says! Why? because Peter wants to put his story in front of God's story. We need to be attentive to God's Word today so we can address our disullionment!
