Who doesn't want to be on top? I think everyone of us want to be on top even if we do not want to admit it. It is wired into us since infancy. We want to be great in life, work, among our peers, even in the eyes of God. We probably want attention, recognition, approval, applause. Maybe we want power or control. Maybe it is the way we deal with our fears or our insecurities and doubts.

But maybe, we just want to be like someone else. We admire some person, the qualities that he has, the talents that she may have. Maybe it was a teacher, a family member, or a colleague, or a hero. Maybe that person is comfortable in his own skin, grounded but not stuck, successful, but not arrogant, deeply centered but always open to others. They attract us. They show something about ourselves. They help us see new possibilities in our lives. What if that is what led James and John to ask? It is a bold request.

Jesus does not say no, does not dismiss or judge them. Instead, Jesus takes the occasion to teach them what greatness and glory look like. And they don't look like what most of us have been told they do.

Greatness and glory involve selfsurrender. It involves listening, of serving, and caring for others. It is connecting with God, of being peacemakers, of hungering and thirsting for justice, and offering forgiveness. All these and much more.
