John the Baptist believed that the time had come, so he prepared himself by a simple way of life. The question that was asked of John is the same question that we need to ask also today: "What must we do?"

"Be content with your pay." What does that mean today with the high cost of living? It probably does not mean that labor and management should squeeze all they can out of each other, that strikes and layoffs should be arbitrary tactics. It could mean that people are worthy of their hire. It could mea that we should be careful for competitveness, be wary of ceaseless striving, be aware that we live by more than bread.

"Don't bully" might mean that you and I must not overpower each other physically, emotionally, or spiritually, that we do not violate other persons.

"If you have two coats and some food, share with those who don't" does not mean that we should have the best clothes, the best cars, the best food, the best homes that we can afford. What it means is that we must not define our worth in terms of what we have, or allow ourselves to be valued for what we own.

Following the example of John the Baptist or Jesus does not mean we cannot enjoy the good things of life. The question is: "How much must we share? "How much pleasure are we permitted in the face of another's pain?
