The sacrament of Baptism is a one time event. Once you are baptized, you are sealed forever to be a child of God, a member of Christ's body on earth, and an heir of the promised glory in heaven.

Although it is a one time event, the sacrament is renewed each day as we say "yes" to the Will of God, when we separate our life's wheat from our life's chaff, growing more fully and authentically ourselves, connecting and strengthening our bond with God and and with others.

So perhaps, we can start asking ourselves today if our lives are growing, expanding, and engaging to the fullest possibility of who you are as God's child? Are you living your life or someone else's? Whose voice are you listening to? Such questions help us to dig deeper - the winnowing fork is as much part of baptism as is the font. We all have wheat and chaff, yes, each one of us, but it is not a judgment. The separating is about discernment between what feeds, nourishes, and grows life and what does not.

But we need also to recognize that the chaff has a purpose. It is the outer husk that protects the wheat. Without the chaff the wheat cannot survive but at some point the chaff no longer serves a purpose. In fact, it restricts the wheat and needs to be removed and thrown away. What is the wheat of your life that needs to be gathered? What is the chaff of your life that neecs to be burned?

WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

January 19 to 25

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is an annual ecumenical celebration. Christians around the world are invited to pray for the unity of all Christians, to reflect on scripture together, to participate jointly-organized in ecumenical services, and to share fellowship. In the northern hemisphere, the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is traditionally held every year between January 18th (the Feast of the Confession of Saint Peter) and January 25th (the Feast of the Conversion of Saint Paul). In the southern hemisphere, it is often celebrated during the Pentecost season. Your communities are invited to choose the dates that would be appropriate for your context. In the Gospel of John, Christ prays for his disciples before going to the cross. He asks that his followers "may all be one," as he and the Father are one, "so that the world may believe" and have life in his name (John 17). Christian unity is here made central to the very being of the church and to its mission and witness.

Today, we live with divisions even as we yearn for the unity promised and commissioned by Christ. The long and often painful history of Christianity has sundered our churches for theological, liturgical, and political reasons. Many Christians now strive to heal these divisions, yet honour our diversity, through ecumenical dialogue, common action, and relationship-building. They also come together to pray for unity, joining Christ in his prayer to the Father. The worldwide celebration of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is both the seed and and the fruit of this striving for 'unity in diversity'. This time of shared prayer, reflection, and fellowship invites Christians of different traditions to deepen our relationships and to live and witness together throughout the year.
