

A good number of us may not have been on top of a mountain, but there are probably times in our lives when we felt we were on top of the world. What was the experience like for you?

Perhaps, it felt like everything was just right, full, soaring, perfect. Perhaps, it was a feeling of being part of something larger and beyond yourself. Perhaps, you have exclaimed you never want that moment to end. Could it be that the Transfiguration was like that? Yes, something wonderful happened on Mount Tabor, but the story did not end there. Jesus and the disciples had to come down from the mountain into the valley of disfiguration, where life is hard.

As soon as they arrived below, they were met with a very difficult situation - a desperate and scared plea from a father and the utter helplessness of the other disciples. When have you felt overwhelmed, powerless to do anything? When did it look like everything was falling apart and you were crashing?

The gospel story seems to present to us this tension, the contradiction in our lives. There are valleys and there are mountains. You may feel so blessed today and the person sitting beside you in Church is feeling the opposite. Perhaps as we gather around the Table of Plenty, we come in our joy and in our sorrow. Whatever we may be experiencing at this moment, may we find at this Table, the transformation we are looking for, the deepening of love that we are yearning for, and God revealing Himself to us even more.


ShareLife Sunday is March 30. Our parish goal for this year's campaign is [insert goal amount].
