

THE PASCHAL FAST

Let the paschal fast be kept sacred. let it be observed everywhere on Good Friday and, where possible, prolonged throughout Holy Saturday, as a way of coming to the joys of the Sunday of the resurrection.



Haven't you noticed the gospel today from St. Luke does not speak of palms? The people spread their cloaks on the road but there is no mention of palms! St. Luke does not describe the usual triumphal entry that we are used to. What Luke describes might be more accurately called the tearful entry because immediately following on verse 41, the gospel writer tells us that "as Jesus came near and saw the city, he wept over it". I wonder if that is also how we should approach the Holy Week - with tears and weeping.

We have much to weep these days - just look at the global economic chaos unleashed by one man and the trust that was already fragile and further weakened. This Holy Week however reminds us once more about the river of love, compassion, and heartbreak flowing between Jesus and the city - but the city is not just Jerusalem, it is also our beloved Mississauga, where we are right now. If ever there is lack of hospitality and welcome, if income inequality prevails, if fear and hate based politics are present, if we refuse to humble ourselves and ask for forgiveness, Jesus weeps.

If we are not happy how our lives are going, if we are running away rather than face the problem, God is calling us back and the way of return is through the Holy Week. Jesus wept, so we must also weep. Let our tears mingle with His.
