Do you remember that our parish church was solemnly dedicated on May 2, 2018 by H.E. Thomas Cardinal Collins? We thank God this weekend for such a grace!



In the last couple of days since we celebrated Easter Sunday, we have been as a Church experiencing Easter like no other. Pope Francis went home to the house of our Heavenly Father on Monday of the Octave of Easter. Several years ago, the same happened with Pope John Paul II on the Eve of the Divine Mercy. Both proclaimed in action and words the Gospel of Mercy.

In today's Gospel story, the gospel writer did not only tell us about the breakfast that Jesus had with the disciples. He also included other details which were very ordinary, such as Peter going fishing, catching nothing, feeling so vulnerable and exposed, but may just point us to the reality of Easter.

What if Easter is not just about an empty tomb and people meeting Jesus alive immediately following the discovery of the rolled stone? Perhaps, Easter has more to do with the ordinary and the familiar, very much like the disciples who were back in Galilee, who found themselves doing their old routine of fishing, to the same boat, the same water, the same work, the same frustration - and it was there that Jesus "showed himself."

Except perhaps about the coming conclave, most of us are back to the everyday routines of our life - what if Jesus really wants to meet us where we really are? Just because your net is empty, don't throw it away as of yet. It is when our nets are empty... and when the jars are empty as it was in Cana, that Jesus comes to us.
